Getting out the vote to re-elect Council Chair Judy Davis, in the municipal election on Tuesday, March 10, 2015, is our **Number One Priority**. The SICA Political Action Committee (PAC) endorses Council Chair Judy Davis because she supports the issues concerning Singer Island residents.

Blvd, Room 2401, Palm Beach Gardens. **Early Voting:** Complete an application or cast a 'walk-in' absentee ballot from February 23rd through March 9th.
